Being a maternity, newborn and breastfeeding photographer has helped shaped moments of my life unrelated.


Watching women enter this sacred right of passage and see it all the way through is truly a testament to the woman.

After we have hopped on our call, it's time to plan all the details together. This includes outfits, colors, pinterest boards, etc.




FINAL TOUCHES.
